

CHARM Consent

In an effort to improve services to you and your child and make certain that your child's health care providers have up to date information about your child's health condition, the Utah Department of Health (UDOH) has established a confidential and secure electronic data management system called, Child Health Advanced Records Management (CHARM).

CHARM connects specific UDOH programs like Baby Watch Early Intervention and the Utah Statewide Immunization Information System (USIIS) so that providers of your child's care can access and review information about your child such as: screening results, immunization status, assessments, referrals, treatment plans, and follow-up services.

With your permission, CHARM can share and access contact and health information with the following authorized users:

1. Birth and Death Certificates
2. Newborn Hearing Screening
3. Newborn Screening (heelstick) Program
4. Immunization Program
5. Birth Defects Registry
