



Child Health Advanced Records Management (CHARM) Consent

In an effort to improve services to you and your child, the Utah Department of Health has established a confidential and secure data system called "Child Health Advanced Records Management" ("CHARM").

CHARM supports the sharing of health information by connecting the data systems of specific Utah Department of Health programs such as Baby Watch Early Intervention, Newborn Hearing Screening, and the Utah Statewide Immunization Information System. CHARM allows only authorized health care providers access to your child's health information for treatment purposes and clinical care coordination services. Authorized health care providers are required to sign a confidentiality agreement and follow confidentiality policies. Data shared electronically through CHARM is encrypted and protected through strict security procedures.

CHARM does the following:

- Links electronic data and health care services so that important health information (address, assessments, eligibility, and services) about your child is accessible for use;
- Helps you and health care workers know what services your child has had or still needs;
- Improves follow-up health care for your child, and;
- Ensures continued security of health information.

With your permission, your child's Baby Watch Early Intervention contact and health information will be shared electronically through the CHARM system with Newborn Hearing Screening.
